

Case1 Chest Pain

- 90-year-old man
- Suffered from chest pain at home
- 18-lead ECG: tachycardia, ST elevated
- Troponin T rapid test: positive
- Diagnosed as AMI and VT
- Transported to an angiography room at Hôpital Européen Georges-Pompidou

- 40-year-old man
- Drank toilet limescale remover at home
- Diagnosed as acute intoxication
- Intubation in the ambulance
- Transported to the Poison Control Center
