






Yokohama now is the second largest city in Japan.






Yokohama was the base of foreign-trade in Japan 150 years ago and become the most western-like city in Japan back then.



Derived from the second oldest Western-style hospital in Japan established in 1871 by Yuteki Hayashi, a doctor and a businessman.

In 1952, Merged with faculty of commerce of YCU

In 1905, Established as the Straits Settlement and Federated Malay Straits Government Medical School





Medical interview

Monitor

Assess vital signs and physical symptoms



Treatment

Give a patient some intervention



Assessment

Assess an outcome of the intervention

3. Medical Interview





In each scenario, a trained actor or actress played a patient.

Taking informed consent

Rendering appropriate information to a patient without using technical terms

Consider backgrounds, personality and feelings of a patient


