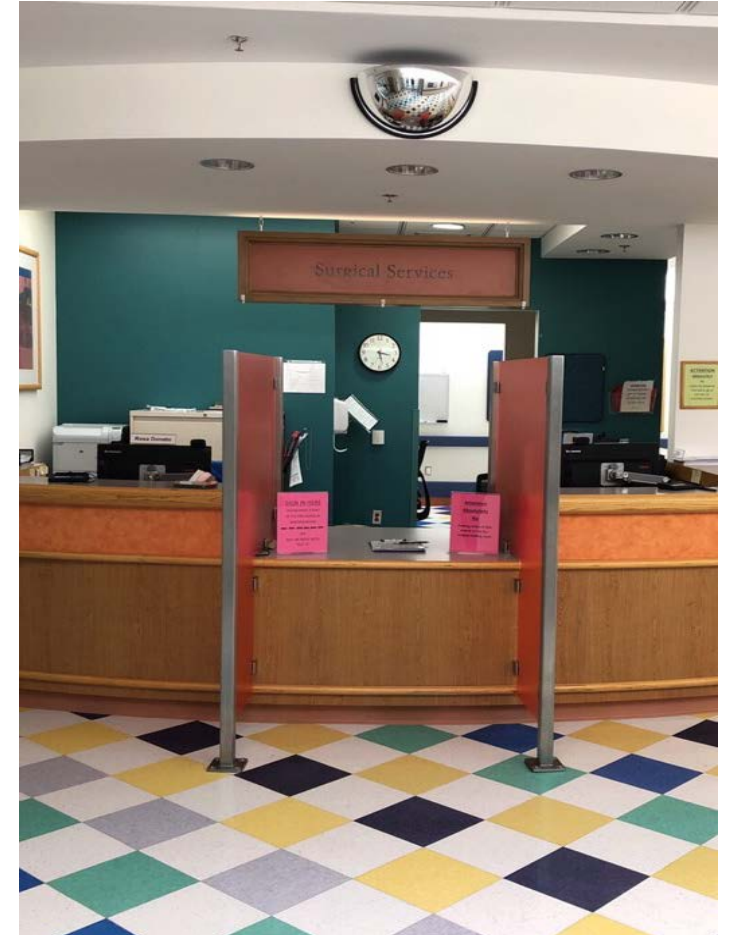

- Reinforce communication skills in English

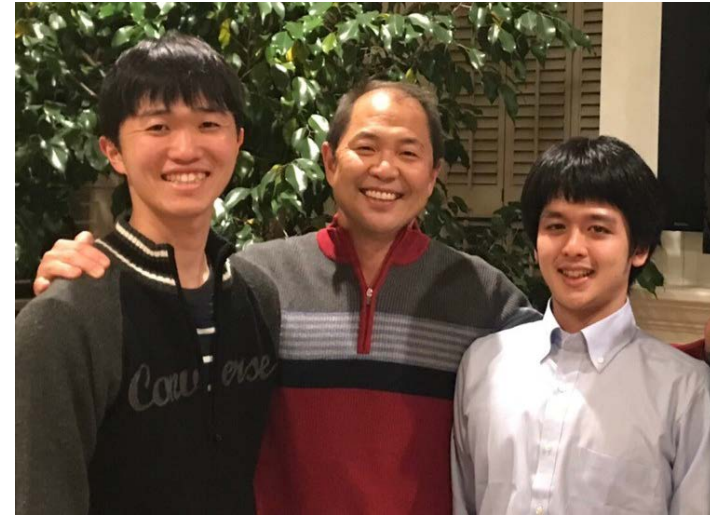
Surgical departments
